The match between the University of Münster (GER) and Valladolid (ESP) started the day. The Valladolid team took the advantage in the first half when they scored three goals while Münster scored one. But Münster made use of the second half to catch up with Valladolid. Eventually, the Spanish team won 3 - 4 in a very close game.

Later, the University of York (GBR) fought University of Örebro (SWE). Unfortunately for Örebro, they lost against their British rivals in the second half of the match, after reaching a tie (1 to 1) in the first half. The final result was 4 - 1.

Finally, the last match of this venue was the Norwegian School of Economics (NOR) against University of Neuchatel (SUI). It was the Norwegians' first

However, the game between the University of Cork (IRL) and Tromso Students Sports Club (NOR) was more exciting since the match was bitter. In the end, the Irish beat the Norwegians. The final result was 6 - 5.

Siberian, Rouen and Minho take the lead

The second day at El Maulí Sports Hall turned out to be an intense one

It was a very intense day at El Maulí Sports Hall here in Antequera, with plenty of exciting and interesting matches taking place and a very warm audience that supported every team that played at El Maulí.

The day started at 9:30 AM with the Zurich (SUI) - MAMI (RUS) match, in which the Russian team dominated the field and managed a score of 1 to 8. It was followed by the match between the Dnipropetrovsk National Academy of Ukraine

Sligo won against Szczecin in a very heated match with an impressive score of 13 to 7

(UKR) and the University of Minho (POR) at 12:00 AM, in which the Portuguese girls managed to control the ball and their opponents, and achieved a win with a score of 1 to 5. At 2:30 PM the Sligo (IRL) - Szczecin (POL) match took place, a game in which both teams went all out and ended with an impressive score of 13-7 in favour of the Irish team. In the afternoon, at 5:00 PM, the Universities of Tampere (FIN) and Rouen (FRA) played a very interesting match in which the Finnish team risked

it during the second half by having their goalkeeper assist her teammates on the attack. Unfortunately for them, the French girls ended up winning with a well deserved score of 1-3. Also, Duclaud from the Rouen team had to be assisted by the medical team on the first half, but fortunately their swift intervention meant that she had a quick recovery and could play on the second half of the match. Finally, the team from Siberian Federal University won against the University of Malaga with a score of 4 to 1. The local team was not able to overcome the Russians, whose defensive play proved to be an excellent counterattack against the continuous advances of the Spanish team.

With these results, the Universities of Siberian (RUS) and Rouen (FRA) in group A, and Minho (POR) in group B, lead their groups and are in a

However, Dnipropetrovsk (UKR) and the Norwegian Univ. of Science and Technology (NOR) will surely raise to the challenge in hopes of snatching a much needed win.
