The men group phase ended yesterday

Half of the Championship is over, today the quarter finals will take place

The rankings have already been decided

The match played at the TAC Sports Hall at 19:30 was one of the most exciting seen so far in the Championship. In the first half, the match was so tight that none of the teams seemed able to score. Both teams turned from defenders into attackers in a matter of seconds.

This balance was broken by the Russian team when they scored two goals before the break. In the second half, as the Russian scored again and again, the Norwegians seemed to be discouraged, but still they put a fight to their rival. With this victory, they have managed to raise up in the ranking.

The teams from Spain, Russia, France, Croatia, Portugal and Turkey lead their respective groups.

The day started with the match between the Sumy State University (UKR) and University of Applied Sciences Talin (EST). The Ukrainians won the game in the first half, 6 to 1. But the Estonians were not dishearted, they were able to sneak in some balls and scored 5 goals more. Even so, the Ukrainians won the match with the result of 8 to 6.

The second match confronted the University of Jyväskylä (FIN) against Münster (GER). Finland

Kyolä Mikko scored four of the seven Finnish goals against the University of Münster

scored three goals before the break already and four more on the second half. Kyolä Mikko scored 4 of them. Unfortunately, the player number 11 from Germany had to be medically assisted. The final result was 7 - 1 for the Finnish.

In the afternoon, the University of Vern (CRO) fought against York (GBR). The Croatian gave no quarter to the British. The winners of the match were the Croatians as the result was 11 - 1.

The matches in the Argüelles venue began with

the competition between Jozef Rusiecki Olsztyn University College (POL) and Cyprus University of Technology (CYP). The game was balanced, but the Polish were more effective on reaching the rival's goal. Final result: 7 - 4 for Poland.

Next match confronted the University of Minho (POR) and Cork (IRL). The game was really easy for the Portuguese team. Minho's strategy was unstoppable, for the Irish found the Portuguese constantly at their goal. The final result was 19 - 1.

In the afternoon, the University of Paris paired against Azerbaijan State Academy. The game seemed to be quite tight in the first half of the match. But it was in the second half when the goals came. 5 for the Parisians and 3 for Azerbaijan.

The last match confronted Malaga (ESP) and Neuchatel (SUI). The game was won by the Spanish team

although the defense of Neuchatel performed quite well since Malaga missed several chances to score.

Antequera gets ready for the second half of the 3rd Futsal women championship

EL Maulí Sports Hall hosted the third day of the women competition

We are almost at the equator of the championship, and all the teams are giving it all in order to reach the semifinals. Yesterday's matches at El Maulí Sports Hall were a wonder to watch and the audience livened them up despite the city of Antequera's hot weather.

The Zurich (SUI) - Dnipropetrovsk (UKR) match started the day, a game the Ukrainians clearly

dominated. Both teams were evenly matched, but after five minutes the Swiss goalkeeper had to retire from the game due to an injury and that lowered their morale. The Swiss girls would end up losing 1 - 11. The Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NOR) - Moscow State Technical University MAMI (RUS) match was next. The excellent job done by both goalkeepers meant that the first goal didn't come until 9 minutes had passed. The final score was 0-5 in favour of the Russians, but both teams played an excellent defensive game. The players from MAMI, however, accumulated a total of five yellow cards. As for the next game, the Siberian Federal University (RUS) won a very close match against the Tampere University of Technology (FIN), with a score of 2 to 3. On the other hand, next match turned out to be one-sided as the French team from Rouen ran off with the game and ended up winning with a score of 1 to 10. The French team played very aggressively, scoring 3 goals when only 3 minutes had passed. Their

opponents, the Polish team of Szczecin, played valiantly but their risky strategy proved to be their downfall in the end, as leaving their goal unattended prompted several counterattacks from the Rouen girls. Finally, the local team of the University of Malaga (ESP) got their first win against the Institute of Technology of Sligo (IRL) after a very intense match in which the Spanish team proved that they still have what it takes in order to enter the semifinals. The final score was 7 to 1.

The Universities of Szczecin and Tampere have lost their chance to classify for the semifinals. Norwegian also has a very slim chance to enter the semifinals. However, they still have a pretty good chance to get into the matches for the 5th to 8th position and will surely try their best. On the other hand, Minho, MAMI, Siberian Federal University and Rouen are all in a great position and only depend on themselves to classify to the next round. Of special interest are the matches between Rouen and Sligo in group A, and between Minho and Zurich in group B. Both games will shape the future of the championship as well as determine whether Zurich and Sligo can still make it. Furthermore, the Universities of Malaga and Sligo need to win all their remaining
