Paris and Valladolid advance to the final

Istanbul (TUR) and Vern (CRO) will compete for the third position in the rankings

The first half of the match between Neuchatel (SUI) and Orebro (SWE) was clearly dominated by the Swedish team, as Neuchatel could not approach their goal. However, on the second half Neuchatel's spirit rose and they put up a fight, but the advantage the Swedish had accumulated on the first half proved to be too much and the Swiss lost by four to nine. The other Swiss team, Geneva, won on the penalties against the Turkish team of Marmara. With four minutes left on the clock, the Swiss team was losing by two goals, but they made a comeback and ended up winning in the end. Also, the German team

of Münster won against the University of Cyprus with a score of six to four. Cyprus scored the first goal, but the Germans quickly retaliated with three more and that sealed the fate of Cyprus. Even though they kept up with the Germans, they could not overcome them

and they ended up losing the game. But the matches that gathered the more noticeable crowd were the last 3 games of the day. First, Malaga team played against Minho. These two teams were among the favourites to win the championship, but they were put aside by the French and the Turkish (Istanbul), respectively, in the previous phase.

At the beginning of the match, Minho took the lead with two goals and although the local team tried to even the scoreboard the Portuguese were able to maintain the distance in a very calculated game. The defense of Minho stopped most of the shots from Malaga. The game ended up 2-4.

On the other stadium, Argüelles, the match was played between Valladolid and Vern. The first half of the match ended in a draw (1-1) in spite of the support shown by the local fans for the Spanish team. A few moments later from the beginning of the second match Valladolid scored two goals in the same minute and as a counterattack Croatia advanced with his 5 players attacking. But their strategy was

weak and they could score not one goal. Valladolid triumphed over the Croatians. The other match that

moved the crowd was Paris - Istanbul. Paris' imposing goalkeeper put the Turkish attacks to test. In the first half, Paris took the lead and the Turkish could not overcome the French team. They lost inevitably to Paris and its unconditional fans.

Merethe, their captain, declared that "it was a tough match and Championship, we had good teams in our group. Then, in the afternoon, the much awaited semi-finals took place. First was Minho (POR) - Siberian (RUS). As expected of a game featuring two of the best teams in the Championship, the game was blazingly fast with plenty of opportunities for both teams. The Portuguese, however, were more effective and ended up winning by three to zero. Rita Sá, the Minho goalkeeper, said that "we are going to fight with everything we have, because together as a group we are strong". Finally, the
