# Closing and Awards Ceremony of the 9th European Universities Futsal Championship

Last Sunday the Championship came to a close with the Closing and Awards Ceremony that took place after the men's final. First there was a march-past featuring a representative of each team bearing their flag, followed by a speech given by the authorities that helped organise this massive

undertaking: Mrs. Isabel Calero representing the University of Malaga as Vice-rector of University Extension, Mr. Manuel Barón representing the city of Antequera as his Mayor and Mr. Wolf Fruhauf, honorary member and representative of the EUSA Executive Committee.

After the appearance of the authorities, the Awards Ceremony started. Aside from the main awards, that of European Champions which was

awarded to the Universities of Valladolid and Rouen in men and women respectively. ance of Elena Garrido, the promising young singer from Antequera who also sang at the Opening Ceremony. She performed "We are the Champions" beautifully, and the athletes proceeded to move to their seats afterwards. Afterwards, Mr. Wolf Fruhauf was given the EUSA flag by the volunteers, whose work is what made the Championship possible among other things. The EUSA flag was handed over to the University of Poznan (Poland), that will organise the next European Universities Futsal Championship. Mr. Piotr Kus from Poznan University gave a welcome speech, in order to conclude this transition between Antequera and Poznan. Finally, Ana Pozo's flamenco group interpreted typical flamenco music and dancing and the host officially announced the end of the 9th European Universities Futsal Championship.
