The Spanish team, new European Universities Champion

Valladolid rises to new heights in Antequera

The University of Paris lost unexpectedly against the Spanish team

There was a great atmosphere this afternoon at the Fernando Argüelles Sports Hall, which was bustling with activity at 6:30 PM. The audience, of around 1500 people, was eagerly awaiting the match between our two finalists: the Universities of Valladolid and Paris. At the start of the match, the University of Valladolid, the underdog of the Championship,

started dominating the pitch. Álvaro Ballesteros and Enrique Molina led the Spanish attacks during the first minutes, but they could not get past the imposing figure of the Paris goalkeeper, Mostafa Mohammed. Nevertheless, while Valladolid controlled the ball France led dangerous counterattacks which were stopped by the Valladolid goalkeeper, Victor Gutiérrez.

The second half was a succession of frenzied counterattacks from both teams

near the end of the first half, reaching the break with a score of one to two in favour of the Spanish team.

Right at the start of the second half, Abdessamad tied the game again. Now it was their turn to dominate the pitch, but that would not last long as after a few minutes, both teams continuously counterattacked each other in a flurry of advances which were stopped by both goalkeepers who did a magnificent job. Finally, Javi López from Valladolid managed to overcome Mostafa with eight minutes left on the clock. France switched to five against four, with Julien Sakrani entering the pitch. Enrique Molina took the chance to score again and increase the distance with the French team, who would finally be defeated by the Spanish players. The University of Valladolid celebrated their victory with their audience at Antequera, who were a big support for them.

The Spanish attacks led to Álvaro Ballesteros scoring their first goal after eight minutes had passed. However, France did not relent and Sid Belhaj quickly tied the game three minutes later. From this point on, neither team dominated the pitch and the attacks kept alternating from one team to the other. The French attacks were led by Abdessamad Mohammed, brother of their goalkeeper. Nevertheless, David Manrique from Valladolid scored again

Futsal at its finest: Rouen, Euro Champion

Minho controlled the ball yet Rouen defended well

The long awaited women final between the Universities of Minho (POR) and Rouen (FRA) started at 4:00 PM at the Fernando Argüelles Sports Hall. There was a great following, both at the venue itself and on the internet through social networks.

Fanny Gosseye from the University of Rouen scored the first goal after eleven minutes had passed in the first half

On the first half, both teams exerted great pressure over their opponent which meant that there were not many approaches to the opposing goal. It wasn't until eleven minutes had passed that Fanny Gosseye from France scored the first goal, which made Minho increase their pressure. However, despite their attacks, Laurene Duclaud from the French team scored again in a counterattack. Taking advantage of their favourable position, France concentrated on defending their area and made it really hard for the Portuguese team to approach their goal, which meant that at the break the score was still two goals to zero in favour of Rouen.

Right at the start of the second half, Melissa Antunes from Minho shot a diabolical ball which was bravely blocked by the French goalkeeper. Minho's approaches would continue throughout the whole second half of the game. However, while the Portuguese team has great players with an outstanding performance, as a

group Rouen displayed much better teamwork. That combined with the skill of Marlene Petit, the French goalkeeper, meant that Minho was not able to get past the French goal. Rita Sá, the Minho goalkeeper, also did a great job, continuously blocking the French counterattacks.

The last five minutes of the match were frenetic, and it looked like anyone would have been able to win even though France had the advantage. Minho tried to play five to four as a last resort, but France controlled their attacks with its great defense. Fanny kept a close eye on Melissa, the best player from Minho, and greatly impeded her movements. On the last minute the Minho coach asked for a time out, but their strategy did not bear fruit and Minho lost the match irrevocably. The University of Rouen now bears the right to be called the best in Europe.
